DIRECTOR'S NOTE

Little Orphan Annie, the comic strip made its debut 100 years ago, in August of 1924... and here we are now, telling her story again.

You might think a character born a century ago might not have relevance today, but as you watch tonight see how many parallels you can find between the show, set in 1933, and our current reality, 2025.

I think why we all still love, and come back to, Little Orphan Annie is because of her never ending optimism, her ability to always see the good in people, her constant reminder that no matter what, tomorrow is only a day away—so make the best of it.

She's not the typical heroine either—I can't take credit for this, and I am paraphrasing—but I'll never forget a conversation I had with another theatre colleague who pointed out that her "want song," typically much later into an act, opens the show. We know right away what Annie's objective is, and it's not the typical ingenue's wants, usually a rescue of sort or to champion at something. No, all Annie wants is to know that she is loved, that somewhere there is a place for her. She is not afraid to be bold and vulnerable, honest to her core.

I guess my hope for you tonight is, aside from taking away the tremendous performance this cast will give you, is to remember to be hopeful. To be optimistic. To cling tight to things that spark joy in you. And if you might have trouble with any of those, remember—tomorrow is only a day away.



CHARLOTTE VAN LEDTJE (Annie) is delighted to make her debut at Rochester Opera House. Matilda: (Matilda, Winnipesaukee Playhouse), Frozen: (Young Elsa, Ogunquit Playhouse), Sound of Music (Brigitta Von Trapp, Ogunquit Playhouse), White Christmas (Susan Waverly, Maine State Music Theater), Mary Poppins (Jane Banks, Portland Players), Aristocats (Duchess, Ovation Theater Company), The Nutcracker (Clara, Portsmouth School of Ballet). A twotime National Dance Title Holder. Charlotte loves learning new ballet variations and taking contemporary classes. SCOTT H SEVERANCE (Warbucks) has over 450 professional credits as actor, director, producer and playwright during his multiple award-winning career. Scott has starred as Scrooge in national touring productions of A Christmas Carol for the past eleven years, including three times in his critically acclaimed one-man version. He has played the iconic role of Tevye in Fiddler on the Roof in ten different professional productions (including ROH last summer) and earned standing ovations at every turn. Local appearances have included Harold in The Full Monty and White Dude in The Toxic Avenger (ROH), Max Prince in Laughter on the 23rd Floor (SRT), and Edna in Hairspray with Patrick Dorow Productions. A Boston area favorite for years, favorite roles include Major-General Stanley, King Arthur, Kris Kringle, Pseudolus, Benjamin Franklin, Oscar Madison, Don Quixote, and Nick Bottom. Film credits include Fever Pitch with Drew Barrymore and Clear History with Larry David. Scott will direct The Little Mermaid this summer at ROH.


Community Events and Rentals




Seating Chart
